Get your pet up to date on their shots!

Pasco County Animal Services wants to make sure that your pets are up to date on their vaccines!

We are now offering \$15 microchips, \$8 for a one year rabies vaccination and \$13 for a three year rabies vaccination.

The vaccination clinic will be every Wednesday from 9am-11am. If interested in the 3 year vaccine, please bring previous rabies certificate (cannot be more than 30 days past expiration date).

PCAS encourages pet owners to bring out their healthy, non-pregnant cats and dogs so that they can be vaccinated against rabies.

Pet owners who purchase the low cost rabies vaccines will also be required to obtain a County cat or dog license. Please refer to the Pasco County Animal Services website for County license fee schedule. The County licenses are required by ordinance for both cats and dogs and can only be issued with proof of current rabies vaccination. Please visit

Per County Ordinance, cats are now required to be licensed!

A cat license identifies and protects in the event that a pet gets lost. Even indoor cats can get out and become lost. A license is not only a requirement but it provides many benefits:

-A license is the difference between a pet and a homeless stray.

-When licensed, found pets can be quickly reunited with the owner.

-A license is proof that a pet has been vaccinated against rabies.

-License fees support the return of lost dogs

and cats and help adopt homeless pets to new families.

-Pet licenses also fund animal neglect/cruelty services, spay/neuter programs, and community education services.

Pet licenses can be obtained through Pasco County animal Services via mail, in person, at the Hudson Library or through the veterinarian administering the rabies vaccine. A rabies certificate (an invoice or statement is not sufficient) and proof of spay/neuter, if applicable, is required when purchasing a license. For more information, please visit:
